

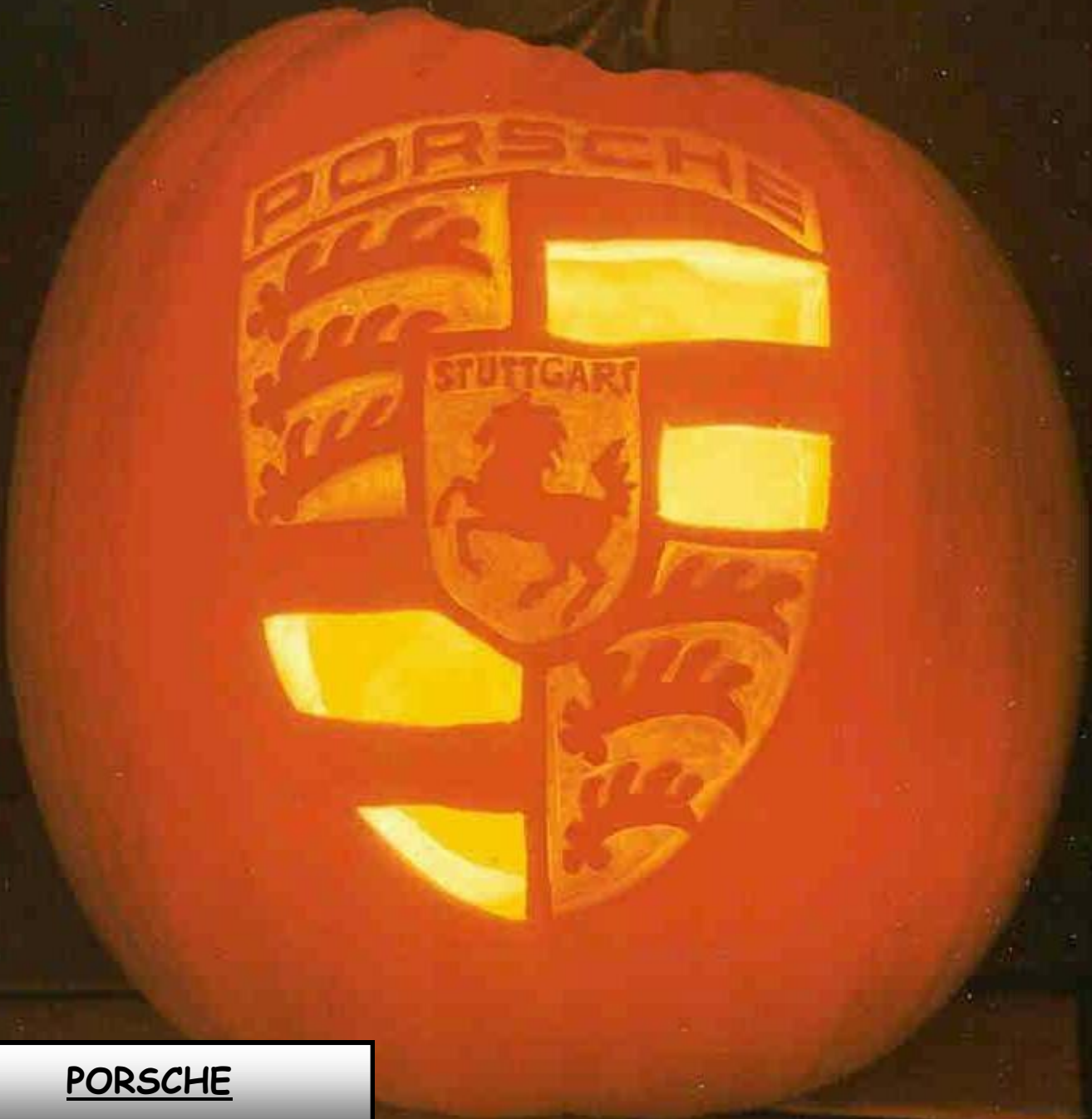

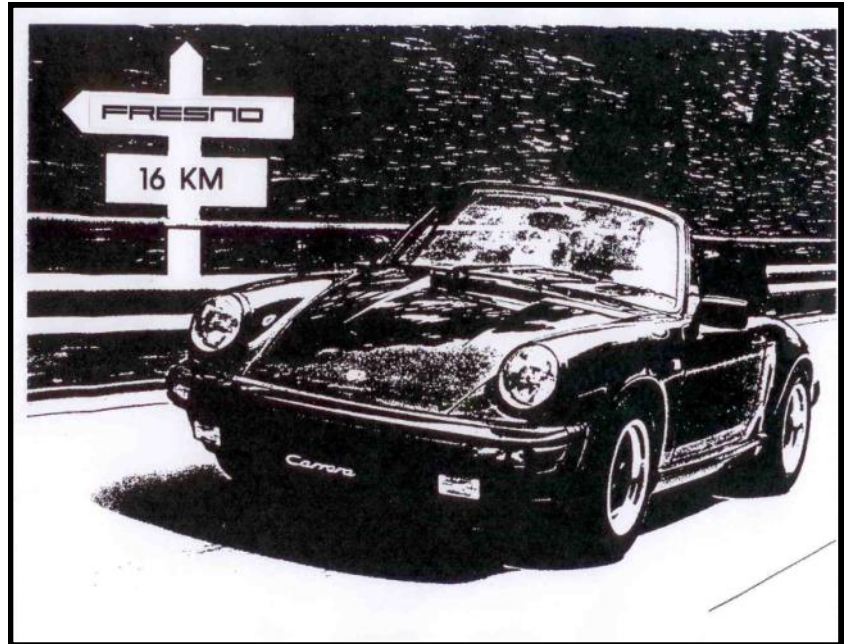

## CERTIFICATE OF AUTHENTICITY

### **Do you have a Certificate of Authenticity for your classic Porsche?**

Porsche of North America has a program for owners to obtain information on what kind of Porsche it originally started life as. Many years ago this information was stored on a Kardex. Porsche kept a card (similar to a card catalog of American libraries) that contained information helpful for them to keep track of original equipment for warranty servicing of the cars.

As the years went by, many times this information was accessed by owners to determine what was original equipment, was the 356 speedster a Carrera 4-cam? or a plain jane Speedster? It was helpful when selling cars, for collectors, or those undertaking restorations.

Most of the inquires in the early days were towards the 356 cars. You actually got a photocopy of the original kardex. Now the service is available for any Porsche model, and you receive a Certificate of Authenticity

With more cars around, and this service being more widely known, Porsche Cars of North America (PCNA) set-up a service, the Certificate of Authenticity program. The original kardex is not available to owners anymore, but a frameable piece of paper is now delivered to the owner. Please download the current form to learn about fees and timeframe. This process does take a tremendous amount of time to research, be patient.

Currently the Certificate of Authenticity includes your vehicle's original factory specifications, production completion date (Birth Date) and manufacturer's suggested retail price (MSRP).

The document can be framed or laminated to your choosing, and discounts are offered to PCA members. The form on the next page can be filled out and Faxed to Porsche

What nicer gift could you bestow upon a loved one, friend or even yourself, than to give or receive a Porsche issued Certificate of Authenticity? This valuable document includes your vehicle's original factory specifications, production completion date (Birth Date) and manufacturer's suggested retailprice (MSRP). This can prove to be invaluable for restoration, resale and for displaying your Porsche at official Porsche concourse events, such as the annual Porsche Club Parade. It also makes a great addition to your trophy case!

Based on the fee chart below, you can order a Certificate suitable for framing. For 1993 or older models, if you provide a legible copy of the original Monroney Label (Window Sticker), you will save \$10.00 off the prices listed. Porsche Club members will receive an additional \$10.00 discount. Please allow 4 - 6 weeks for delivery.

## AUTO-CROSS

### Spring & Summer Auto-X

Some members have never attended an auto-x event. You could be a new member or racing has never been your thing. Just about everyone who has attended an auto-x event has ended up having a blast. Auto-X is fun for Sunday drivers as well as the hardcore racer.

Here's how it works: We generally show up between 7:30 & 8:00 a.m. Kevin Molineaux, our board member in charge of competition has pre-drafted a drawing of the course—it changes every event.

The course that the club uses is a large parking lot in Kerman, CA. Just 5 miles east of hwy 99 on the left. If you've made it to hwy 145, you gone too far. The course is easy to see as the 10 acre parking lot with 3 large warehouses on it is in the middle of grape vineyards.

Everyone pitches in setting up the course which will consist of hundreds of small orange cones, a timer system, the main tent where the score keepers keep track of your racing times.

Before the races begin, Kevin takes everyone on a quick walk thru the course and explains the rules.

Rules? Yep, there are a few. Drivers race one at a time. You get to do one practice lap and them a timed lap immediately following. Each car gets to do a set of 5 practice/timed laps. The goal is to race thru the course as fast as you can without knocking over any cones - each knocked down cone adds a second to you time. The cones are really small so as not to cause any damage if they get run over (and it always happens).

The drivers are split into two groups (a & b). While group a races, group b monitors the course and calls in any knocked down cones (we all get walkie-talkies and a safety flag)

Each driver is required to wear a helmet and if you don't have one, the club has several that can be



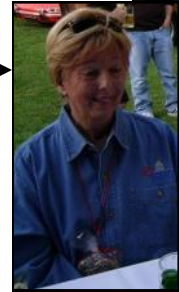
